LEGAL RAMIFICATIONS OF SUBSTANCE USE

MINOR TRANSPORTING (IN POSSESSION) MGL Ch138 §34C

Police officer may arrest without a warrant

- being under 21 years of age,
- > and not accompanied by a parent or legal guardian,
- knowingly possesses, transports or carries on his person,
- > any alcohol or alcoholic beverage.
 - o Misdemeanor Fine of NMT \$50 for the first offense NMT \$100 for subsequent offense. 90 license suspension.

Persons attempting to purchase alcohol MGL Ch138 §34

Police officer may arrest without a warrant

- > any person under 21 who purchases or attempts to purchase alcohol;
- > any person under 21 who make arrangements with any person to purchase or procure alcohol in anyway;
- \triangleright any person under 21 who willfully misrepresents his/her age or falsifies identification offered as proof of age;
- b whoever makes false statements as to the age of a person under 21 in order to procure alcohol.
 - o Misdemeanor Fine of \$300. 180 license suspension.

OPERATING UNDER THE INFLUENCE (UNDER 21) MGL Ch90 §24

Police officer may arrest without a warrant

- Person under 21 operating a motor vehicle found to have a blood alcohol content above .08.
 - o Misdemeanor 2½ years in a house of correction, NLT \$500 NMT \$1000 − 1 year license suspension.
- ▶ Person under 21 operating a motor vehicle found to have a blood alcohol content above .02.
 - o 90 license suspension Under 18, 1 year license suspension.

DRUG OFFENSES

Police officer may arrest without a warrant

Conviction of any drug offense, whether in Massachusetts or another state, even if no motor vehicle was involved in the offense, the offender's license *will* be suspended. 1 to 5 years license suspension, depending on the conviction.
